- Delivered by a qualified early childhood education teacher



- Aligned with the Queensland Kindergarten Learning Guideline, or other education program approved by the Queensland Studies Authority
- For at least 15 hours a week, 40 weeks a year or a minimum of 600 hours over 37 weeks for services operated by non-state schools.
